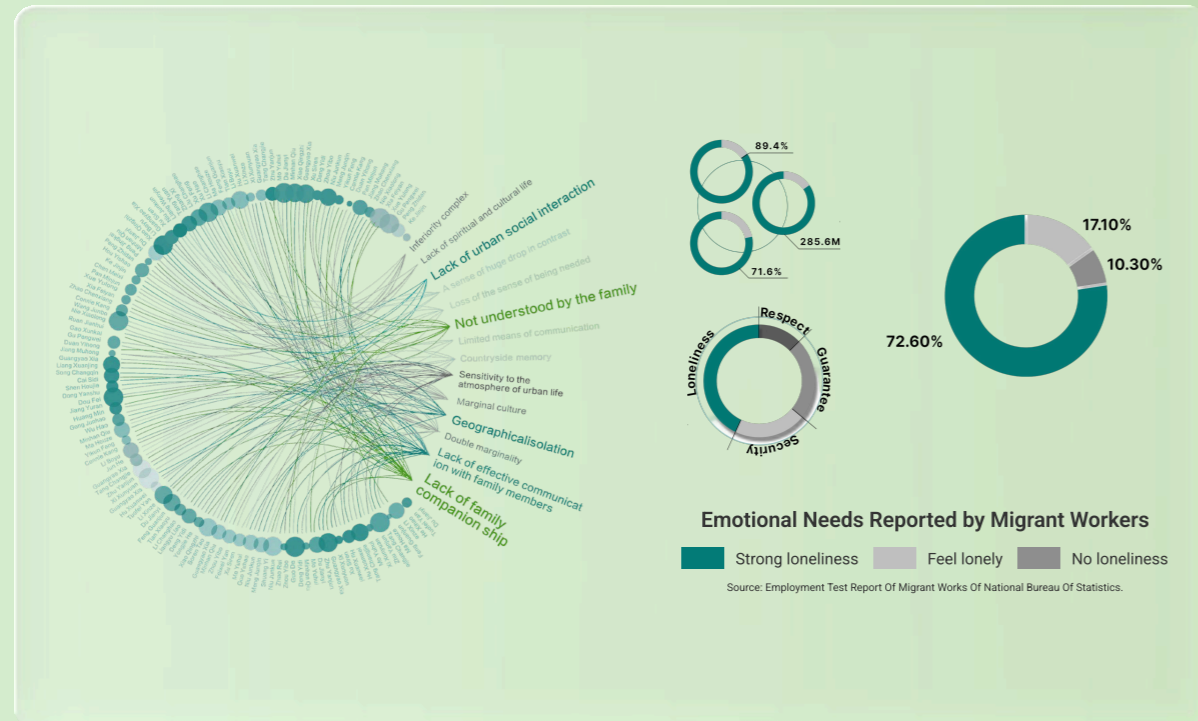
Interview with Local Workers

Through interviews and field research, I found that migrant workers' loneliness is strongly linked to family separation. Combined with economic pressure, younger workers—especially those new to city life—experience this sense of isolation more intensely.



Cause Analysis of Loneliness

From 143 interview and survey responses, multiple structural causes of loneliness emerged. Family distance remains one of the most defining factors.
