



Family Re:union

Millions leave home to build cities that rarely belong to them.

Many migrant workers spend years away from their families. Most communication is limited to quick phone calls, missed messages, and money sent home—thin connections trying to hold a family together. Family Re:union tries to ease this distance. It uses simple technology to turn a worker's daily tools and work patterns into small signals their families can see and understand. A moment of activity on the job becomes a small sign of presence; a routine task becomes a form of reassurance.

By treating work data as a way of showing care, Family Re:union brings attention to the hidden emotional labor within migrant families. It also suggests a more humane way for construction companies to use digital management, bridging the gap between workplace systems and family life.
